



PROFESSOR ĐORĐE PAUNOVIĆ

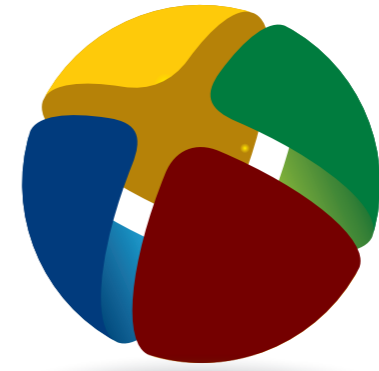
Professor Đorđe Paunović was born in 1938 in Belgrade. He graduated from the School of Electrical Engineering at the University of Belgrade in 1962, received his PhD in 1978, and was elected to all academic positions from Assistant to Full Professor.

All scientific and professional papers of professor Paunović represent the result of needs, activities and experiences drawn from engineering practice. Professor Paunović was a great lecturer and pedagogue, but also a great manager. The cooperation he established with domestic and foreign companies enabled the School's participation in important telecommunications projects. He was the designer of a great number of projects for numerous clients in Serbia and in the region. The activity of particular significance of professor Paunović refers to the international level within the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers (IEEE).

Professor Paunović was Dean of the School of Electrical Engineering for two terms of office, Vice-Chancellor of the University of Belgrade and a Regular Member of the Academy of Engineering Sciences of Serbia.

As one of the initiators and founders of TELFOR, professor Paunović was the president of the Board of Directors of the Telecommunications Society and TELFOR from its establishment in 1993 until 2021.
